Interactive Traffic Safety Education for Teens

What We Do

This high school event teaches teens about basic automobile maintenance and traffic safety. The interactive, 45-minute program also explains what to expect during a routine traffic stop with law enforcement.

Part 1 Hands-on walk around of a vehicle, including:

- How to jump start a dead battery
- How to check tires for proper inflation levels
- How to change a tire or use the spare
- Going over the seven major fluids and where they are located
- Proper driving and mirror position
- Items to keep in your car
- How to install snow chains (for Northern Nevada)

Part 2 Mock traffic stop with Law Enforcement, providing:

- An interactive opportunity for teens to experience a possibly stressful situation in a controlled environment
- Education on what to do and what to expect
