## What We Do

D.R.I.V.E. is a driver's safety course, designed by Nevada Highway Patrol Troopers, created to help young drivers understand the dangers of driving. Through educational videos, pictures and real life stories, Troopers help teens to develop a new perspective on road safety.

## Why We Do It

Too many teens die on our roads, and in many cases, if these young drivers had been properly educated in safe driving practices, they would still be alive today. The D.R.I.V.E. program is an opportunity to help teens be responsible and safe while riding in, or driving a vehicle.
